Attached, you will find a three page "wish list" we have compiled of the projects we hope to accomplish this year through our volunteers and work teams/days. As you can see, it is quite extensive. Choose what you think your group can manage (i.e., don't be scared off by the large amounts of paint needed or many areas needing to be painted!). Just do what you can. Every little bit will be greatly appreciated! We only ask that if you should, for example, choose to paint the bathrooms in one of the lodges, that you not leave the job unfinished. Please finish what you start. (We'd hate to have only a partial wall painted somewhere, and no other group coming behind you to finish up!)

We have a Project Wishlist you can access through www.lowes.com. This is the list of supplies that can be purchased at Lowe's. Here are the instructions for locating it:

1. Under "First Name" please type in "Camp Grier."
2. Under "Last Name" please type if "Project Wishlist".
3. Then click the "Find" button. It will take you to another page where "Camp Grier Project Wishlist" will be underlined and in blue (about 3/4 of the way down the page).
4. Click on that and you should be able to see our Wishlist.

If you are able to purchase supplies cheaper on a local level, please do so, but be sure to call Jan at Camp Grier – **828-668-7793** and let her know so she can take them off the gift registry at Lowe's. We do ask that paints and stains come only from Lowe's so that we may be consistent in colors/types.

Please NOTE: We need four (4) shower stalls, but for some reason, the gift registry site at Lowe's will only let us list one (1). Also, the registry site does not list the paint color. You will need to specify the color as **#6007-3A – Ginger Sugar**

We also request that you call Jan and let her know which project(s) your group is wanting to work on. This way she can let you know if another group has already requested that project.
