** EQUIPPING HEALTH CENTERS **

The other goal this year is to equip each of the outlying ten health centers with a kit of most essential items.

- ✓ Digital thermometers (CENTIGRADE, not Fahrenheit)
- ✓ Blood pressure cuff sets (such as Tyco)
- ✓ Giant sized bottles of liquid hand sanitizer
- ✓ Hand cranked flash lights (no batteries needed)

It is important that the thermometers and blood pressure cuffs be suitable for repeated use, not the less expensive ones for home use.
