Dice Question Game

Small groups of 4-6 or with a partner (you can have everyone change partners after a couple of rolls of the dice for each person) Groups share by answering the questions through the rolling of the dice. They answer the question that corresponds to the number on the dice.

Example – questions written below used to dig into the story of Jesus Walking on the Road to Emmaus.

- 1 Tell about the last time you were surprised by a visit from someone unexpected.
- 2 Do you like surprises? Why or Why not.
- 3 Tell about a time that you saw something and thought it was one thing and it turned out to be a completely different thing or situation.
- 4 What is the biggest leap of faith you have ever taken? How did it turn out?
- 5 Share two words that describe God for you.
- 6 If Jesus sat down next to you on a bus, what is one question you would ask him?

Statistical Scavenger Hunt Give groups a score sheet and have them add up their total points, based on the following:

- Add up all their birthdays (the day of the month)
- Add up the different birth places (cities)
- Add up the number of watches in the group
- Add up the number of hospital stays
- Add up the number of siblings
- Add up the number of different colored socks
- Add up the different kinds of toothpaste used
- Add up the number of contacts in cell phones in the group
- Add up the number of days missed of school so far this year
- Add up the number of pets for the group
