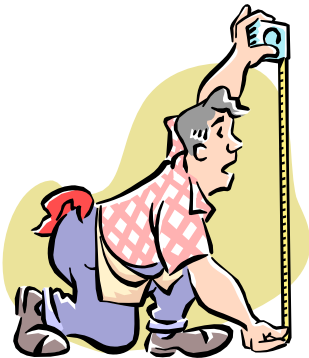


CAMP GRIER

As is typical for this time of year, it is a time of low revenues for the camp, so we are asking for your financial assistance, as well as your physical help.

PROJECT LIST & COST

1. **Repair/replace roofs on the cookout shelters (seven in all). Approximately \$600 per roof. Please bring ladders.**
2. **Cookout shelter fireplaces need repair work done to them. Masonry block construction. \$15 - \$60 per fireplace, depending on degree of repairs needed (mortar mix, concrete mix, concrete blocks).**
3. **New shingles nailed on all bridges and steps up to buildings. \$0. We already have the needed shingles.**
4. **Steps built to first two swings on road coming into camp. \$0. We already have supplies.**
5. **Trail maintenance to the Rhododendron Trail, Lake Trail, and the Creek Walk Trail, as well as the road to Rock Slide and Wildness campsites. \$0. Please bring your own chain-saws, etc.**
6. **Hinges on doors at Wildness and Rock Slide need to be reversed. \$0. Should be able to use same hinges.**
7. **50+ mattresses have been given to us that have been stored for a long time. They need a good scrubbing! Please bring Clorox, rags, and rubber gloves**
8. **Windows need washing. Please bring Windex and rags with you.**
9. **Firewood cut and split. \$0. Please bring your own chain-saws. We have a wood splitter.**
10. **Picking up sticks and general grounds clean-up around Camp. Please bring your own rakes, gloves, etc.**
