The Lodge can accommodate sixty-four overnight guests, with a dining room serving three delicious meals daily. A number of the rooms have been refurbished providing all of the rooms on the first and second floors with private baths. The third floor has hall baths that work well for large groups.

With the adjoining W. H. Belk Conference and Worship Center, accommodating eighty-five people, it is a perfect place for meetings, retreats, family reunions and for groups attending conferences. The Conference and Worship Center is also available for rent for outside groups for a nominal fee.

The newly decorated living room with its mica rock fireplace is a cozy spot for conversations, games, or reading. The rocking-chair porch overlooking Montreat is a favorite spot for guests most of the year.
