July 20-24, 2010

THEME

The theme for the 2010 event is “For Such a Time as This” – a powerful cry from the book of Esther. “For Such a Time as This” was seen by the design team as an encouragement to be courageous, to be faithful and to be attentive to God. To listen deeply to God and to respond, with the extraordinary gifts given to young people, to a world in need of Jesus’ story and the gospel messages that inspire us to act. And in particular, for YOUNG PEOPLE in the Presbyterian Church to be aware of their call to act as agents of healing, hope, and holy transformation in this world and in this church

EVENT OVERVIEW

The Delegation of Western North Carolina Presbytery will meet on July 19 in Black Mountain and get on the bus to arrive at Purdue University on Tuesday afternoon, July 20. Triennium begins with registration, recreation, a meal, and a vibrant worship experience. It will conclude on Saturday, July 24, with a challenging call in worship to go forth into the world. In between, all of the participants will experience small group meetings, recreation, a spirituality center, worship, singing, personal interaction with youth and adults from all over the world, and learning about Reformed identity, ministries, and vocational opportunities. The Triennium is geared toward high school youth with special emphasis on spiritual formation and Christian discipleship.

WHO

Youth and adults from the Presbyterian Church (USA) and Cumberland Presbyterian churches will attend. They will come from every part of the United States and several parts of the world. There will be high school student participants and leaders, adult advisors and leaders, as well as college students who will participate in the Work Crew to support the event.

PRESBYTERY OF WESTERN NORTH CAROLINA DELEGATION

WNC Presbytery’s Delegation will consist of 44 youth and 6 adults.

The Presbytery Youth Ministry Committee will make every effort to accommodate each young person’s desire to be on the Presbytery’s delegation. However we will also be considering budget limitations and the intent to be inclusive of all congregations interested.

Therefore, please take seriously and work diligently on your answers to your application questions and the reference.

FEE

Cost of the conference for the participant is \$298. Registration includes cost of the Orientation Retreat, transportation to/from Triennium, on campus room, meals, t-shirt, and all program fees. *Because the cost of the Triennium registration and orientation is actually much more, each youth is receiving a \$136 registration fee credit (plus transportation credit of \$120 per person) from Western North Carolina Presbytery.* Additional expenses to each participant will be three “on the road” meals, souvenirs of their choosing, and snacks during the week.

Local churches are encouraged to consider paying half of the \$298 Participant Registration Fee. All participants are expected to bring back experiences and learning that will benefit not only themselves, but their local churches and the presbytery.
