Colleen and Ken have handed over the different responsibilities to the staff members and we trust they will run the school smoothly during their absence.

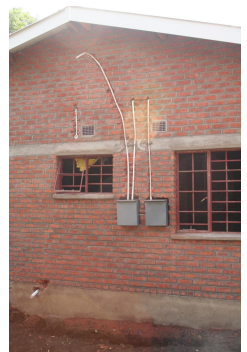
Progress on the Staff House
