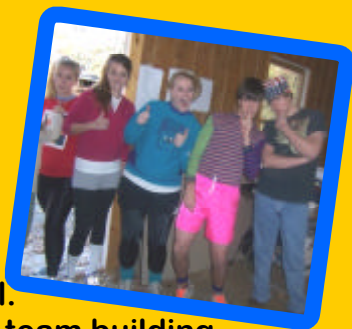
You could have all of these opportunities and so much more by joining the **Presbytery Youth Council.**
